Subject: Grant of authorization under Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling)
Rules 1998.

Sir,

Please refer to application no. nil dated 08.01.2015 in connection with the subject cited above. Your application for grant of authorization has been scrutinized and the officers of the Board have inspected your hospital. On the basis of the recommendation of inspection report, the state POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD grants authorization for a period of 31.12.2015 on trial basis with the following conditions-

- This authorization shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, and the rules made hereunder.
- The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection to the request of an officer authorized by the U.P.P.C.B.
- The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the Bio-Medical Waste without obtaining prior permission from U.P.P.C.B.
- Any Unauthorized change in personal, equipment of working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute breach of this authorization.
- It is your duty to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility.
- You shall ensure that Bio-Medical Waste generated in your hospital should be handled without any adverse effect to human health and the environment.
- You shall ensure that Bio-Medical Waste shall be treated and disposed off in accordance with schedule I and in compliance of the standards prescribed in schedule V of the Bio-Medical Waste Rules.
- Bio-Medical Waste shall not be mixed with other wastes.
- Bio-Medical Waste Shall be segregated into containers/bags at the point of generation in accordance with schedule II prior to its storage, transportation, treatment and disposal. The containers should be labelled according to schedule IV.

- 10. If a container is transported from the premises, where Bio- Medical Waste is generated to any waste treatment facility outside the premises, the containers shall, apart from the label prescribed in schedule III, carry information as in schedule IV.
- You shall also ensure that untreated Bio-Medical Waste shall be transported only in such vehicles as may be authorized for the purpose by the competent authority as specified by the government.
- 12. No untreated Bio-Medical Waste shall be kept stored beyond a period of 24 hrs. If it becomes necessary to store beyond 48 hrs, you must take permission of the U.P.P.C.B. to ensure that it does not adversely affect human health and the environment & store in cold containers till 48 hrs only.
- 13. You shall submit an annual report to the prescribed authority in form II by 31st January every year to include information about the category and quantities of Bio-Medical Waste handled during the preceding year.
- 14. You shall maintain a record of the generation, collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal and/or any form of handling of Bio-Medical Waste in accordance with these rules which can be inspected by U.P.P.C.B. at any time.
- 15. You shall submit a regular air monitoring report to the Board to ensure smooth functioning of incinerator, if used and regular transport the solid waste of the hospital to the incinerator of the service provider.
- You should ensure the development of proper Green Belt in and around your Institution and also ensure Rain Water Harvesting in your premises.
- It is within power and function of the U.P. Pollution Control Board to modify/revoke the terms and conditions for the authorization issued under the Rule 8(2) of the Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rules 1998.
- You shall ensure obtaining consent under Air and Water Acts, from the board. Submit status and testing reports of E.T.P. and S.T.P. effluent within 15 days to this office.
- 19. Any type of breach, at any time, in any of the above mentioned conditions will resulted in the revoke of this authorization, without any priors notice and legal action will be initiated/forwarded against your institution.
